Description of services:

Tampa Parks and Recreation Department operates a variety of facilities such as community centers, art studios, swimming pools, and gymnasiums that offer a wide range of programs including after school care, art instruction, dance, gymnastics, and sports leagues.

The Tampa Parks and Recreation Department manages, maintains and operates all the park and recreational facilities of the city, and develops and implements programs for cultural and recreational activities.

Community recreation opportunities are available for all persons regardless of abilities or disabilities. The Special Programs Section of the City of Tampa Parks and Recreation Department provides outreach activities for people of all ages with mental and physical disabilities, and are designed to promote physical, mental and emotional well-being.

Eligibility for services, if required: Programs are open to anyone regardless of residence location.
